

Bethlehem Inland Wetlands Agency (IWA)

Standard Permit Conditions for All Permits

- 1. Notification in writing to the Land Use Coordinator (LUC) 5 business days prior to start of work.**
- 2. Notification in writing to LUC when work is completed.**
- 3. Inspection and signoff of soil and erosion control measures by LUC prior to start of work.**
- 4. All work and all regulated activities conducted pursuant to this permit shall be consistent with the terms and conditions of the permit. Any unapproved activities shall constitute a violation of the permit and may result in its modification, suspension or revocation.**
- 5. The permittee shall employ best management practices consistent with the terms and conditions of this permit to control storm water discharges and to prevent erosion and sedimentation and to otherwise prevent pollution of wetlands and watercourses. Immediate notification of LUC of any problems involving wetlands or watercourses that have developed in the course of, or that are caused by, the approved activity.**
- 6. The applicant shall provide a 24/7 phone number of the responsible site supervisor to the LUC before any approved work can begin.**
- 7. The permittee shall maintain sediment and erosion control at the site and such controls shall be inspected for deficiencies at least once per week and immediately after rains. Deficiencies shall be corrected immediately, and controls shall remain in place until disturbed soils at the site are stabilized.**

Special Permit Conditions That May Be Imposed

- 1. A performance bond with proper surety shall be posted prior to the start of work in the amount specified by the IWA.**
- 2. Other conditions as dictated by the IWA.**
